PUBLIC TENDER NOTICE

The National Ports Agency (ANP), acting as the Granting Authority, is launching an international public tender for the selection of a specialized operator to be awarded a 30-year concession for the development, outfitting, operation, and maintenance of the New Casablanca Port Shipyard.

The the New Casablanca Port Shipyard consists of four types of infrastructure: (i) a 244 m x 40 m dry dock, (ii) a 150 m x 28 m lifting platform with a capacity of 9,000 tons, (iii) a 62 m x 13 m dock equipped with a 450-ton strap gantry crane, and (iv) outfitting quays with a total length of 820 linear meters. The shipyard also includes 21 hectares of backfill land.

An Information Memorandum, providing a detailed presentation of the project, its context, and strategic importance, is included in the tender documents.

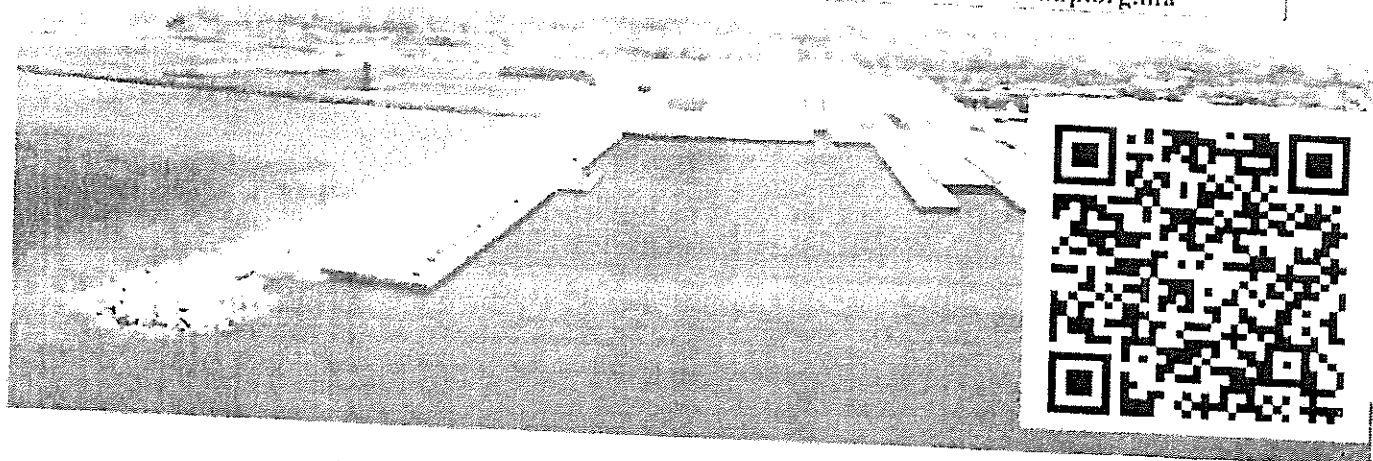
Eligibility Criteria

This tender is open to applicants -- whether based in Morocco or abroad -- with at least ten (10) years of proven experience in the operation of shipyards comparable to that of Casablanca Port. Applicants may apply individually or as part of a consortium led by a company meeting the aforementioned experience requirements.
